

**St. Coleman's 27th Annual Italian Festival**

Dear Junior-High Parents,

As you know, junior-high children must complete service hours during the school year. They may work a maximum of 2 shifts at the Italian Festival. All students must work for their own community service hours; a student may not accept donated hours. Students may work at the following work areas:

- ❖ We have student positions available to help the adults at the GAME BOOTHS. Each grade sponsors a game booth at the festival. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade 50/50 raffle is a great way to work with your kids. Stroll around the festival grounds and sell raffle tickets with them! (Opens Friday at 3:30 PM.)
- ❖ Our FOOD ASSISTANT/RUNNER positions are basically general helpers: keeping the food booths stocked with supplies, taking supplies to the Parish Hall, cleaning tables, etc.
- ❖ TRASH BASH working to keep the festival grounds clean. This position will earn **DOUBLE HOURS FOR THE EVENING SHIFTS ONLY** and is also a good shift for parents and kids to work together.

You may submit this form on-line at the Italian Festival Web Site [www.italianfest.org](http://www.italianfest.org), click on Volunteers, and then the Student Volunteer section. Or, fill out this form and place in the volunteer box in the school office or Church lobby.

**Shift times for the students are the same as the adult times, except for the first shift on Friday. Because dismissal is at 1PM, if your child would like to work the first shift, he must report by 1PM; adults will begin their shift at 12:30 PM.** Specify the work area where your child would like to work. Return this form by February 1<sup>st</sup>. The confirmation process for the junior high students will be the same as the parent's. That is, parents must pick-up and sign-for their child's confirmed form:

- After school from February 2nd thru February 5th, or
- At school during After-Care, February 4th , or
- At the Pre-Sale Ticket Table at all the Masses on the weekends of February 6th/7th and February 13th/14th.

Unless you have received written confirmation from the Italian Festival, the work area will not be reserved for your child. In order to receive credit, the student must work the entire shift.
